#### **Hello Quilters!**

Recently I came across some interesting quilting trivia. I thought it would be fun to share with you.

\*What is the greatest investment in quilting?

Time. In some ways time is the greatest investment that you will make in your quilting, but it is often the most misunderstood.

\*What is the average age of quilters? Approximately 65 years old

\*How many quilts does the average quilter make a year? The average quilter today is comfortable with technology, has been quilting for over 10 years, and starts 10-12 quilt projects each year.

\*What does a bear claw quilt pattern mean?

It looks like a giant bear paw. Using this pattern, four bear paws are pointed in a different direction. Some quilt enthusiasts believe this pattern was used to help slaves find food and water during their escape in the mid-1800s. The Bear Paw pattern may have helped slaves know they were on the right track. (Underground Railroad)

We have a natural gift of creativity and originality. We have a rare ability to see connections in patterns, and to draw ideas from many sources.



Our October speaker is Ellyn Zinsmeister. Here is a little bit about her...

Ellyn is a modern quilter, charter member and past president of the McKinney Modern Quilt Guild. She has been sewing for more than 50 years, quilting for more than 25 years.

Ellyn admires all forms of traditional quilts and quilters, but making traditional quilts never quite rang true for her. When the Modern Quilt movement began more than 10 years ago she knew she had found her niche.

Specifically, Ellyn loves improv quilting, saturated solid colors and collaborative quilting projects. Ellyn's work has been published in Quiltcon Magazine (2021), Simply Moderne magazine (2021) and Curated Quilts (January 2022). Her quilt Urban Emergence won first place in the Group Quilts category at Quiltcon in 2021 and hung at Quiltcon 2022.

Most recently, her quilt Darkest Before Dawn won second place in the Group Quilts category at Quiltcon 2023. She loves the quilting community, most specifically her local quilting friends in the McKinney Modern Quilt Guild but also quilters she has connected with around the world.

Ellyn will also be conducting a workshop for us on Wednesday, October 16, from 10-3 at the Roanoke Public Library. Cost is \$10.00 for members. Contact Kathi Runyan or myself if you are interested. The workshop is entitled "Intro to Improv!"


