December 5, 2023

President, Vicky Kidd, opened the meeting at 6:31 pm on ZOOM with the following officers and members present: Vicky Kidd, Kathy Longo, Kay Thomas, Pam Roark, Beverly Douglas, JoAnne Sheppard, Mary Nalley, Aleta Mayrose, and Michelle Lewis. Vicky welcomed everyone to the meeting. November 2023 Board minutes were reviewed and motion to accept was made by Beverly Douglas, with a second by Kay Thomas, and the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Kay Thomas reported for November 2023 an income of \$357.16, expenses of \$311.75, with a net total gain of \$45.41.
