January 21, 2020, BCQG Meeting Minutes Living Word Lutheran Church, Grapevine Texas

Susie Emmons opened the meeting at 7:00pm with a welcome to all members, new members and visitors. Susie read an inspirational message by Jo Gaines. She also announced that there would be a free English paper piecing workshop by Teri Mosher on February 18th.

A motion to approve minutes from the December meeting was made by Chris Sizemore and seconded by Doris Schjelderup. The motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Income from last month was \$1305.46 with expenses of \$1373.82 leaving a balance of \$-68.36. The yearly audit was done by Nancy Carr, Kathi Runyan and JoAnne Sheppard. Any questions regarding audit, please contact our Treasurer, Kay Thomas.

PROGRAMS: Karen Stone will be our speaker for the March meeting.

QUILT SHOW: Linn Jencopale announced that they had their first quilt show meeting. The Quilt Show will start August 13 at the Irving Convention Center. The theme is "Sing Your Own Song". Forms are available March 1st for entering. Entries will be closed May 15th. There will be live music.

Lezleigh Kliebrink announced that there will be a junior section. Categories are: 8 and under; 9-12; and 13-17. Entries will include any textile project that is sewn, not only quilts. There were 50 entries last year.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

COMMUNITY SERVICE: Debra Heid reported that there were 3175.5 service hours and 1091 items donated. These included quilts, baby caps, boutique items, receiving blankets, quilts of valor, Gatehouse quilts, tote bags, items for Days for Girls, Christmas stockings and miscellaneous items. She stated that people are forgetting to log their hours. If unable to make it to the meeting, email her with your hours.

MAGAZINE SWAP: Lauren Friend stated the magazines donated should be quilting and sewing related only. Don't forget plastic bags for mats for the homeless.

MEMBERSHIP: Chris Sizemore announced there were 60 members in attendance, 10 new members and 21 visitors. Susie Emmons announced that every member and anyone bringing a friend to the meeting will be entered into the BAF contest to win 3 hours of organization in your sewing area by Jackie Olson. She will be the August speaker.

NEW MEMBER LIASON: Beth Gerth announced that new members will receive a pin cushion and welcome packet. Visitors will receive a fat quarter. NEWSLETTER: Sheri Jones announced that the newsletter will have a new look soon.
