### North Texas Quilt Festival Update

Many of you continue to wonder what the status is of the August opening of the North Texas Quilt Festival and Original Sewing and Quilt Expo. The Show Committee is continuing to plan for these dates, but we are also developing contingency plans.

1. <u>Entry fees</u> – Enter your quilts, sooner rather than later! No fees will be charged until after July 20th when we are all confident the show will take place.

2. <u>Ticket Sales</u> – Ticket sales can begin a little before Independence Day, 4th of July and we'll have to work hard to get them sold in July and early August.

3. <u>Possible postponement to a future date</u> - If State and local health officials feel it's not safe, then we will announce future dates. But we hope it doesn't come to that. We're optimistic the great state of Texas will begin to reopen businesses in May and we will have the necessary measures and guidelines in place by August.

We're 100% committed to the health and safety of everyone who attends and we'll keep you apprised of the updates and changes we'll be making to assure NTQF is busy but safe for everyone.

Even though it won't be here 'til June 20<sup>st</sup>, summer is just around the corner. Since we are unable to have our regular meeting again this month, I am sending you the next Block Lotto so we don't get too far off schedule. That means we'll be giving away blocks from February, March, April and May at the next meeting. What fun!

#### DIRECTIONS FOR THE MAY LOTTO

Welcome to the May Block Lotto! Since I'm sure we all miss our quilting friends, our block this month is titled "Friendly Hand". It is a 12" finished block and we will be reproducing this block in shades of <u>Friendship</u> (see below). Blocks <u>may</u> contain more than one fabric pattern in each color.

**NOTE:** A limited number of copies of the directions will be available for those of you who are not able to access the

internet. Just let me know you need them and I will email/snail mail them to you.

Remember, you need only make one block per pattern month to be eligible to win blocks for that month at the July meeting. You may make more than one if you would like more than one chance at the finished blocks. Fabrics should be quilt quality and finished blocks submitted should measure <u>at least 12  $\frac{12}{2}$ </u>. **DO NOT TRIM** your finished block. We will leave that up to the lucky quilter(s) who win(s) the blocks.

May blocks should be returned at the next meeting, July 21<sup>st</sup>. The drawing will take place at the end of the meeting. The winner will have enough blocks for a beautiful quilt project. If we receive an abundance of blocks, that will be great – and there could be more than one winner! Questions should be directed to Mary Nalley at <u>mary.nalley001@gmail.com</u>. ### UPCOMING GENERAL MEETINGS:

Susie reported that the secretary, Cindy Barber, of Living Word Lutheran Church, contacted her stating that there would be no group meetings at the church until further notice. We are able to meet there for free, but we do give them a monetary gift of \$750.00 at the end of the year. There was discussion about finding a new temporary place, but most likely the same conditions would exist.

There is no speaker scheduled for June. The pot luck was scheduled and the Quilt of Valor give away. Beverly Douglas reported that the quilt is not finished but there are two or three that are finished. There are speakers scheduled for the rest of the year.

**QUILT SHOW UPDATE:** Linn Jencopale had a meeting April 17<sup>th</sup>. June first is the new deadline for entering quilts. You won't be charged until July or August. The Expo will go on even without the quilt show. There are many new rules and precautions; wider aisles, more spacing. The six quilt guilds that are involved need to be all together and will make a decision by June. If we decide not to have a quilt show, we are not out any money, but we have lost our big moneymaker. Kayleen Allen had concerns about having the Boutique due to social distancing.

**RETREAT:** The new dates are July 23-26. If the decision is made to cancel, refunds will go out closer to that time. There is a minimum of 26 required and social distancing would be difficult.

**COMMUNICATION:** People are grateful for the Thursday emails. Keep the lines of communication open. For the newsletter, let Sheri know what you have been doing: books read, recipes, sewing projects, closets cleaned.
